Players identified as potential cheaters have the opportunity to appeal, but penalties can be significant. Consequences include multi-year bans from ACBL-sponsored games, probation, and even the loss of a percentage of earned masterpoints. Thank you for your commitment to fair play and for helping keep the game enjoyable for all.

In other news, thanks to Wirt Gilliam and our board members for teaching bridge lessons at the North University Community Library. There are only three lessons left in this series, but we hope to offer more in the future. These sessions have consistently attracted a great turnout with many enthusiastic participants.
